### **Invitation to have your say on the Lake Tyers State Park Camping and Access Strategy**

Gunaikurnai Land and Waters Aboriginal Corporation (GLaWAC) and Parks Victoria have developed the Draft Camping and Access Strategy for Lake Tyers State Park following a two-year community engagement process, which is now ready for your review.

The goal of the strategy is to ensure that Lake Tyers State Park continues to be a place to enjoy camping, fishing, boating, walking and other activities in a natural setting, while reducing potential impacts on the land, water and cultural heritage in the park. Considerable effort has been made at locations like the Glasshouse camping area to ensure values are protected while maintaining the bush camping experience.

In drafting the Camping and Access Strategy, current facilities and opportunities in the park have been reviewed and considered for future improvements while prioritising protection of the park's cultural and environmental values.

The strategy considers the following uses:

- Day visitor sites
- Camping sites
- Vehicle and boating access
- Walking tracks

We would like to understand the views of landholders adjacent to the park, park users and the broader community. As the Chief Executive Officer from 4WD Victoria we would value your feedback on the draft strategy.
