

# PLANNED BURN OUTLOOK

FOREST FIRE  
MANAGEMENT VICTORIA

Forest Fire Management Victoria (FFMVic) advise that a number of planned burns have been scheduled to proceed from Wednesday 28th March 2018 within the Midlands District, when fuel moisture and weather conditions are assessed as suitable.

Following the recent rainfall, these planned burns are being closely monitored and once ignition is planned, a follow up notification email will be sent the 24-48hrs in advance of ignition.

Blackwood – Morning Star Track	1km SSE of Blackwood	101.2ha
Blakeville – Cricket Ground Track	1km NW of Blakeville	500.1ha
Blakeville – Hodges Track	1km NE of Blakeville	308.9ha
Enfield – Drevers Road	2km NW of Enfield	286.8ha
Enfield – Oloughlans Road	2km SE of Enfield	279.4ha
Enfield – Parkinsons	5km NE of Enfield	112.3ha
Lyonville – Lyonville Springs Road	0.5km N of Lyonville	120.7ha
Trentham – Old Lyonville Road	2km W of Newbury	182.3ha

Refer to the attached map to review the location of each of the planned burns above, including the other planned burns that may be ignited throughout Autumn when conditions are suitable.

The decision to proceed is made on the day of the burn to ensure conditions are suitable.

To receive up to date notifications on the planned burn program, it is recommended to sign up to the [Planned Burn Notification System \(PBNS\)](#). This system displays all FFMVic burns that are intended to be carried out in Victoria and shows their status. When you subscribe to the system you can customise it to suit your particular notification needs - receiving text messages, emails or both.
