

A temporary road closure will be in place along the entirety of Brahams Road in the Yarra State Forest from Wednesday 13th to Friday 22nd of June 2018, **excluding weekends**. The Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning implement maintenance works to maintain heavy strategic roads to a high standard, ensuring public safety throughout the year. Brahams Road is a major arterial road within the Yarra State Forest with fire access being of main concern, with these works safeguarding it's quality into the future.

Visitors travelling from Warburton are encouraged to travel through East Warburton and access the State Forest via **Muddy Creek Road** off Warburton-Woods Point Road. This will ensure no delays will be experienced to public road users travelling to the Ada Tree and visitors do not travel along Brahams Road during maintenance works. The maintenance works are expected to be completed within 8 working days, however works may be extended if delays are experienced or weather becomes unsuitable.
